

SCGA Super Senior Four-Ball

The Legends at Parris Island May 15-16, 2024

Entry Fee: \$260 Per Team

Eligibility

Open to 2024 male members of the SCGA who are residents of South Carolina. Both players must be at least 65 years of age as of May 15, 2024. Entries may be declined for those individuals who have not had reasonable activity on their club's handicap roster as of the most recent update.

Entries

Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on April 24th. Field will be limited to 50 teams on a first come first served basis. Changes in partners after acceptance of entry and prior tournament history may result in loss of priority. Acceptance will be posted online by April 26th.

Vetting

All players will be required to submit vetting information at the time of registration. Information is also needed for spectators or significant others who may be transporting players to the course each morning. May 1st is the deadline for all vetting information for those not in the tournament.

Format

USGA rules apply, 36-hole four ball stroke play. The field will play in two different divisions, the Championship Division, and the Legends Division. Both players must be 70 years of age and older to be eligible for the Legends Division. Awards will be for gross score only.

Schedule

Upon notification of acceptance, each team will be entitled to 1 practice round. Call The Legends at Parris Island Golf Shop to make arrangements at (843) 228-2240. Practice Round tee times will be on a space available basis.

May 16 Final round 9:00 AM shotgun. Lunch and awards following play
