

# **Inaugural SCGA Par Three Championship**

## 3s Greenville Golf and Grubhouse November 1-2, 2024

Entry Fee: \$200

## **Eligibility**

Open to 2024 male members of the SCGA who are residents of South Carolina. Players must be at least 18 years of age as of November 1, 2024 with a handicap no greater than 8.0 as of the September 6, 2024 update. Entries may be declined for those individuals who have not had reasonable activity on their club's handicap roster as of the most recent update.

## **Entries**

Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on October 16<sup>th</sup>. Field will be limited to 96 players on a first come first served basis. Acceptance will be posted online by October 17<sup>th</sup>. Should the field not reach capacity, the SCGA reserves the right to extend the deadline.

#### **Format**

USGA rules apply, 36-hole stroke play. The field will be cut to the low 36 players and ties after the second round. Awards will be for gross score only. There is no senior division and the field will not be flighted.

- 48 player shotgun start at 5:00PM
- Putting tournament and heavy appetizers. (6:30PM-8:00PM)
- 48 player shotgun start at 8:00PM

## Saturday – Saturday November 2<sup>nd</sup>

- 48 Player shotgun start at 8:00AM
- 48 Player shotgun start at 10:30AM
- Cut to low 36 and ties.
- Final 12 hole round for those that make the cut. Approximately 1:00PM

### Fees

Tournament Fees are paid by the SCGA. All players are required to **WALK** during the event. Practice rounds are available based on the going rate at the host facility and can be booked online.

### Refund
