TO ALL SCGA AMATEUR CONTESTANTS:

Congratulations on qualifying for the 93rd Amateur Championship at The Country Club of Charleston. The SCGA is honored and excited to be playing our Amateur Championship on this historic layout for the 9th time in Championship History.

Please be sure to take the time to read CC of Charleston's welcome letter as the information included will be useful to you during the championship. The following information is also vital for a successful visit to this year's Amateur Championship.

Carts: Please be aware that the **SCGA cart policy** will be enforced. Players may walk or ride and transport their clubs on the cart. Players may **NOT** use a caddie during the event. Spectator carts will not be rented unless a valid SC Handicap issued ID is presented upon arrival and carts are available. **No spectator carts will be available Thursday and Friday.**

Pace of Play: Pace of play is always important in our Championships, but never as much so as in the Amateur. As challenging as the Country Club of Charleston can be, we must do our best as a group during those four days to keep play moving. We have two waves of tee times for the first two days. Please be prepared to do your part in keeping up with the allotted pace set for each round.

Food & Beverage: The turn house next to the Golf Shop will be open from 8:00 AM until 6:00 PM and the Wappoo Café will be open from 11:00 AM until 8:00 PM for your food and beverage needs outside of SCGA meals. **All food and beverage outlets are credit card only.** *The SCGA will be offering all tournament participants a complimentary lunch in the Clubhouse on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.* Thursday and Friday lunch will be offered from 11am until 3pm and Saturday lunch will be offered from 12 pm until 4 pm.

Scoring: Participants will be utilizing the Golf Genius App to enter hole by hole scores. We will designate one participant in each group to keep the scores. Please take a moment to read the Mobile App instructions on how to use the app for scoring purposes. Registration: There will be a registration table for all players to check in at the front lobby of the Country Club of Charleston on Wednesday and Thursday to verify participation. Please take the time to register and receive your tee gifts before playing on those days. Players should report to their starting tee 10 minutes before their tee time to obtain rules sheets, hole locations & announcements.
